

# Personal Scale

## HOME-USE PERSONAL SCALE USER'S MANUAL

SYE-2004A8

### Specification

- Capacity: 180kg/396lb
- Division: 0.1kg/0.2lb
- Available units: kg/lb
- Display for low battery power: "LO"
- Wrong indicate: "Err"
- Over load indicate: "O\_Ld"
- The zero weight display " \_ \_ \_ \_ \_"
- Power: 2 \*CR2032 lithium batteries
- Foot tap start

### Instruction

- Open the battery cover of the scale and set the unit to the preferred measurement kg or lb.
  - Put the scale on a solid and flat floor and make sure the surface of the scale is dry to avoid slip.
  - Tap slightly on the glass of the scale and the display show "0.0".
  - Stand calmly on the scale when "0.0" appears on the LCD display with both feet share the average weight.
  - When weighing, the read-out rises and display flashes till determined.
  - The unit "kg/lb" stops flashing and display your weight read-out.
- Attention: never jump onto the scale to avoid damage.

### Warning Indicate

Lo Replace the batteries if "Lo" appears in the display window.

Err The scale is unable to be used if "Err" appears in the display window. Stand calmly onto the scale to retry after a while.

O\_Ld Recorded weight is greater than maximum.

### Attention

- Results from different scale slightly differ.
- Do not put anything on the scale, unless in use to avoid unnecessary power consumption. Take the batteries out when the scale not being used for a long period of time.
- Keep the scale in a clean and dry environment.
- Your glass scale represents a sensitive electronic instrument. So high-frequency devices may cause disturbance when used in the immediate vicinity. If faults caused in this way, please keep the scale away from the source of disturbance.
- Home-use personal scale, not for commercial using.
